

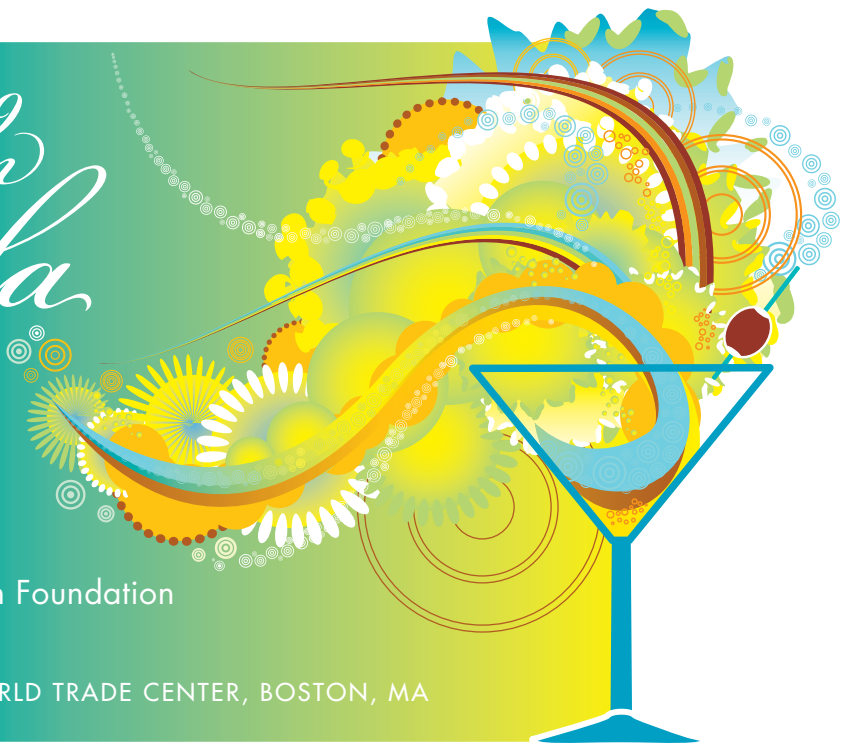

The Seaport World Trade Center is located on the Boston waterfront along Seaport Boulevard. The entrance is across the street from the Seaport Hotel on the second level walkway. The address of the Seaport Hotel is 1 Seaport Lane, Boston, however, the valet parking directions below are recommended for easiest travel.

Parking also available across from the Seaport World Trade Center at the Seaport Hotel garage and in surface lots, both along Seaport Boulevard (one block north of Congress Street).

DIRECTIONS FOR VALET PARKING FOR THE SEAPORT WORLD TRADE CENTER:

FROM Logan International Airport: Follow the exit signs from the airport towards I-90 West - Ted Williams Tunnel. Take the Ted Williams Tunnel to Exit 25 "South Boston". At the top of the ramp, take a right onto Congress Street. At the first set of lights, take a right onto D Street. At the third set of lights (less than ¼ mile), take a right onto Summer Street. Take the first right onto World Trade Center Avenue; valet parking will be straight ahead.

FROM Points West via Massachusetts Turnpike: Follow the Massachusetts Turnpike/I-90 East to Exit 25 "South Boston." At the top of the ramp, bear left towards "Seaport Boulevard." At the first set of lights, take a right onto Congress Street. At the second set of lights take a right onto D Street. At the third set of lights (less than ¼ mile), take a right onto Summer Street. Take the first right onto World Trade Center Avenue; valet parking will be straight ahead.

FROM Points South via I-93: Heading northbound on Interstate 93 towards Boston, take Exit 18/ Frontage Road. Follow Frontage Road and signs for Downtown towards South Station/Atlantic Avenue. Proceed straight onto Atlantic Avenue. Turn right onto Summer Street at South Station. Proceed straight through the next 3 sets of lights. At the fourth set of lights (the Convention Center will be on your right), take a left onto World Trade Center Avenue; valet parking will be straight ahead.

FROM Points North via I-93: Heading southbound on Interstate 93 Boston, take Exit 20A "South Station." At the end of the ramp, take a left at signal, onto Summer Street at South Station. Proceed straight through the next 3 sets of lights. At the fourth set of lights (the Convention Center will be on your right), take a left onto World Trade Center Avenue; valet parking will be straight ahead.
